Interested artists may submit a drawing along with a written description for their original design. Good-quality photos of drawings must be sent as email attachments in a standard image format (JPEG, PDF). A brief description of the artwork should be sent in the body of the email, and artists must also include their professional/gallery/university affiliations (if any), full address and phone number. Artists must be current Massachusetts residents. Work samples and project descriptions must be emailed by March 31, 2016.

Twenty finalists will be selected from digital entry and will be asked to bring in actual work for judging. The winning entry will be chosen by the library's selection committee. The winning artist should complete the proposed piece within six months of the notification of their selection.
